You would be very welcome to join us and enjoy the experience of training with others.

LEADERS

During your first 18 months in Scouting you will be required to complete Modules 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & 19. These will enable you to programme plan effectively and to keep accurate records.

Your training would then continue with Modules 5, 7, 8 & 9, which should be completed within 3 years of appointment.

The remaining Modules, 10, 16, 17 & 18 can be completed at any time during the first 3 years.

Please note that your 1st Aid Certificate must be valid when a Wood Badge is applied for.

MANAGERS

Modules 4, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 & 26.

These Modules are aimed at those in Scouting whose role is to manage and / or support other adults e.g. Group Scout Leaders, Commissioners, Assistant District Commissioners and Assistant Area Commissioners.

They concentrate on the issues of management – managing people, budgets and projects.

Module 25 - Assessing Learning will also have to be completed by Managers.

Module 28 & 29 will enable you to present, train and tutor or facilitate Scout training courses. These Modules are for adults who have completed their own training and show an aptitude to work with others.

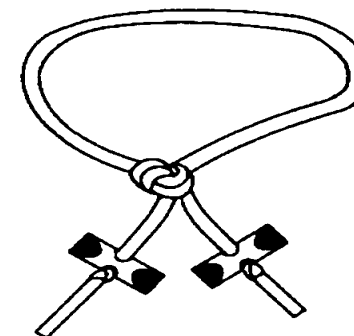
